

PAUL JARMAN

Paul Jarman is a composer, lyricist, performer, musical director, and sought-after conductor, and adjudicator. He has been commissioned over two hundred times. Many of Paul's works have become modern choral standards. His music is published worldwide.

As a cultural ambassador he has worked extensively throughout Australia, Europe, Asia, and North America in festivals and special events, as an artist in residence with choirs, and as a multi-instrumentalist in Australia's pioneering 'world music' ensemble Sirocco, since 1996, representing Australia for the Department of Foreign Affairs. He has also performed on various Australian movies and composed the music to Mike Dillon's award-winning adventure documentary films.

In 2010, Paul's piece for the 40th Anniversary of the death of Martin Luther King Jnr was performed for President Barack Obama in the White House and in 2016, Paul was the only composer from the Southern Hemisphere among a group of some of today's most accomplished choral composers, commissioned by Oxford University Press to write a piece for the 400th Anniversary of the death of William Shakespeare.
